GETTING HERE A short walk from the City centre, Queen Victoria Market is on the corner of Elizabeth & Victoria streets, Melbourne.



BY TRAM: If you're travelling within the CBD, the market is located within the free tram zone. Take the 19, 57 or 59 to Stop 7, Elizabeth Street or Tram 58 to Stop 9, Peel Street.

BY TRAIN: Only a 7 minute walk from Melbourne Central and Flagstaff Stations. Walk north along Elizabeth or William Street.

BY BIKE: There is free bike parking in and around the market. Major bike lanes leading to the market run along Royal Parade and Victoria Street.

BY CAR: Enter the market car park from Franklin or Queen Street.
